

The project was born in 2015 thanks to three Italian schools: *Datini* from Prato, *Aldo Moro* from Santa Cesarea Terme and *Levi-Montalcini* from Acqui Terme. The aim of the project is basically disseminate Italian views on gastro-tourism. "Made in Italy Project" also represents an extremely important moment for students to be trained and live different realities far from home.

"Made in Italy Project" was first introduced in March 2016 at Prato Council Chambers in the presence of Parliamentary secretary for Department of Education, Mr. Gabriele Toccafondi.

and Apulia at Italian Consulate halls.


